

Exam: CARDIO SCAN SELF PAY

CPT Code(s): 75571 - CT HRT W/O DYE W/CA TEST

CLINICAL HISTORY: Coronary artery calcium scoring. Screening examination.

COMPARISONS: None

TECHNIQUE: CT scan of the coronary arteries was obtained without infusion of contrast. EKG gating was utilized during scanning acquisition.

FINDINGS:

The left main coronary Agatston calcium score is 0

The right coronary Agatston calcium score is 0.

The left anterior descending coronary Agatston calcium score is 19.

The left circumflex coronary Agatston calcium score is 7.

The total coronary artery Agatston calcium score is 26.

IMPRESSION:

The total Agatston calcium score is 26. This score places the patient between 25th and 50th percentile in his age group. This score is associated with a least mild atherosclerotic plaque formation. Minimal or mild coronary artery narrowing is likely.
